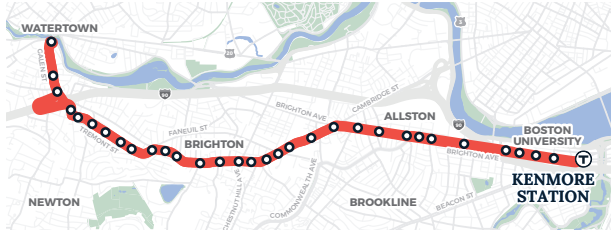


ROUTE 57 TRANSIT PRIORITY CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS
