Project Description:

Project is located at 17-23 Faulkner Street, Dorchester MA, 02124. The scope of work for this project consists of renovations to the building exterior, and improvements to interior areas including occupied units and common areas. These repairs are necessary for building stabilization. We will install new fire safety devices in units and replace appliances. The exterior work planned for the project includes repair/replacement of carpentry items like porch rails, entry doors, trim, soffit and fascia boards followed by a power wash of the building's exterior and a fresh coat of paint. The scope of interior/exterior work does not warrant a relocation of residents. All elements of the scope address immediate needs identified in a current Capital Needs Assessment (CNA) for the property. Support from the City of Housing Boston 2030 Program is necessary and very much appreciated, because the property does not have any project-based rental assistance. Hence, operations have been very challenging and VietAID has spent significant amounts of its own funds to keep up with operating and capital needs over several years.
