Project Description:

The Boston University Henry M. Goldman School of Dental Medicine project is an addition and renovation located at 100 East Newton Street in the South End of Boston. The renovation portion of the project consists of approximately 53,100 GFA of the existing 84,200 GFA building. The new addition is approximately 41,900 GFA for a total building area of 126,100 GFA. The building will continue to be used as an academic/clinical building with a cafeteria on the first floor. The Project will consist of seven (7) levels above grade at a height of 88 ft. above grade. The rooftop penthouse will contain air handling equipment and machine rooms within a corrugated metal panel shell at a height of 95 ft. above grade. A full basement contains mechanical/electrical and support spaces.
