Join the Boston Transportation Department for an update on our work to improve transportation safety in Mount Hope / Canterbury.

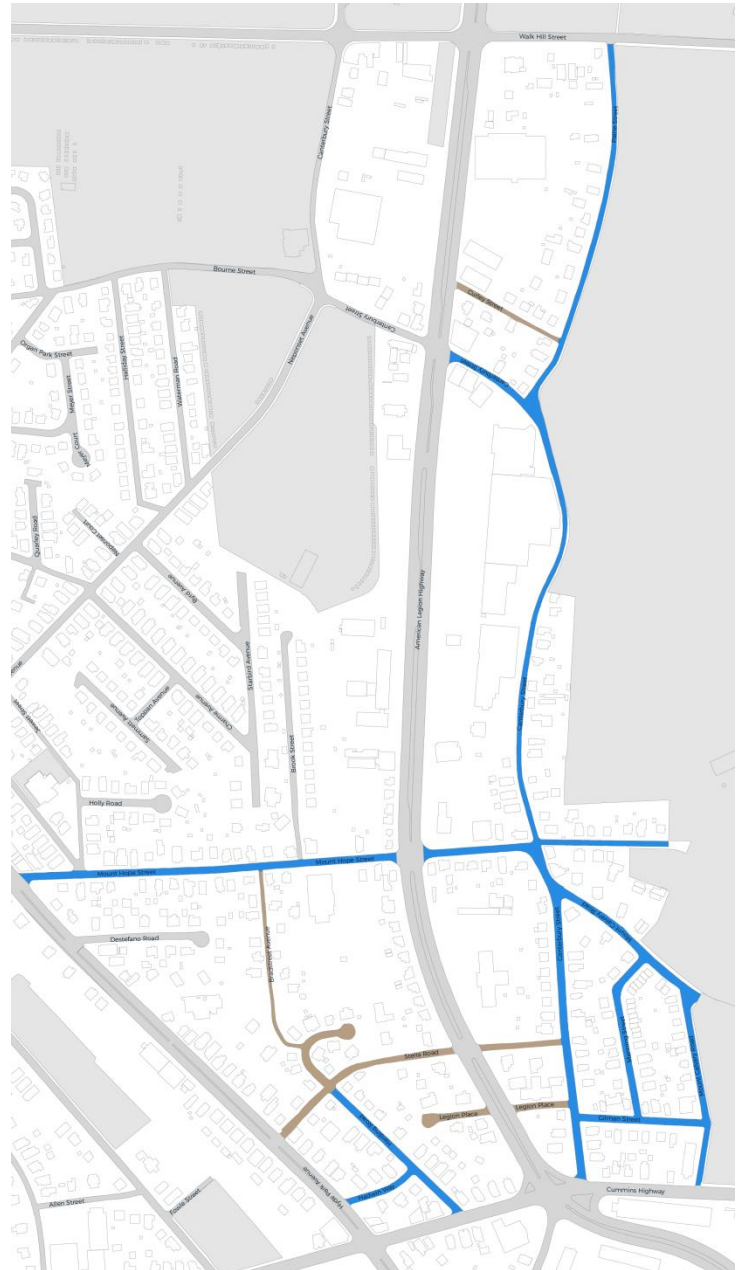
