BEACON HOUSE EXISTING BLACK IRON FENCE TO REMAIN








Elevation on Fence from 36 Joy Court Side











Representative Photo of Iron Fence from Beacon House Side



TO FASTEN THE NEW WOOD FENCE TO EXISTING IRON FENCE WE PROPOSE THE PROCESS THAT EXISTS NOW. 3/4" IRON STRAPPING WITH STAINLESS STL SCREWS FASTENED TO HORIZONTAL WOOD RAIL. WIDTH VARIES AS FASTENING STRAPS WHERE CUT IN THE FIELD FROM ROLL STOCK.


