ORDERED: That the City of Boston, acting by and through its Transportation Commissioner, be, and hereby is, authorized, in accordance with Section 53A of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend a grant from the Boston Redevelopment Authority, d/b/a the Boston Planning and Development Agency, in an amount that shall not exceed Nine Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$970,000) pursuant to the 1350 Boylston Street, Fenway, Boston Project Cooperation Agreement for the purpose of funding the redesign and construction of Boylston Street, as described in the 1350 Boylston Street, Fenway, Boston Project's Transportation Mitigation Commitments.
