## PARKS DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES DORCHESTER TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a public hearing on Thursday, March 5, at 11 a.m. on a request to remove three public shade trees in Dorchester.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) in the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor Conference Room of the Boston Parks and Recreation Department at 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, Roxbury.

The request is for the removal of two honey locust trees measuring 25 inches dbh (diameter at breast height) and one honey locust tree measuring 28 inches dbh due to construction of a mixed-use building at 500 Talbot Avenue in Dorchester.

Public testimony will be taken at the hearing, or may be provided prior to the hearing in writing to the Tree Warden, Boston Parks and Recreation Department, 1010 Massachusetts Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Roxbury, MA 02118 or by emailing parks@boston.gov with "Dorchester Tree Hearing" in the subject line.
