APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

COMMUNICATIONS FROM HIS HONOR, THE MAYOR:

- **0831** Message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) in the form of a grant for the Harrison Albany Block Public Benefits Fund, awarded by the Boston Redevelopment Authority to be administered by the Boston Police Department. The grant will fund the purchase and installation of cameras at O'Day Park, Blackstone Square, and Franklin Square in the South End, under Cooperation Agreement between MEPT/LMP GAMBRQ LLC and the Boston Redevelopment Authority.
- 0832 Message and orders authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) in the form of a grant from ArtLab Cooperative Agreement, awarded by Harvard University Office of General Counsel passed through the Boston Redevelopment Authority, to be administered by the Office of Arts & Culture. The grant will fund the remaining amount of \$10,000.00 per year for 5 years to the Boston Cultural Council Opportunity Fund for the benefit of the Allston-Brighton community. ArtLab grants will support career development for Allston-Brighton artists and free community arts experiences to Allston-Brighton residents.
