The subject of the hearing is:

Docket #0747, Order for a hearing regarding the status of college and university plans to reopen for Fall 2020 amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

This matter was sponsored by Councilors Liz Breadon, Kim Janey and Kenzie Bok, and was referred to the Committee on June 3, 2020.
