COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE - Virtual Hearing

November 20, 2020

The Boston City Council's **Committee on Strong Women**, **Families & Communities** will hold a public hearing on **Friday**, **December 4**, **2020 at 9:00 AM**.

The subject of the hearing is:

Docket #1035, Order for a hearing authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Nine Hundred Sixty-One Thousand Eighty-Six Dollars and Twenty-Nine cents (\$961,086.29) in the form of a grant, FY21 YouthWorks awarded by the MA Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development & Industrial Corporation of Boston, to be administered by the Youth Engagement & Employment. This matter was sponsored by Mayor Walsh and was referred to the Committee on October 7, 2020.

NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum in attendance due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members attending this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.

Attendance In accordance with Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Executive Order modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law and relieving public bodies of certain requirements, including the requirement that public bodies conduct its meetings in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, the City Council will be conducting this hearing virtually. This enables the City Council to carry out its responsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations and ensuring public access to its deliberations through adequate, alternative means.
