





Plan for long-term and short-term improvements for the entire park




WHAT WE HEARD FROM THE COMMUNITY


- Provide a separate fenced dog park

- Study changing the little league baseball field to a multiuse field
- Update the play area



Erosion: add waterbars to direct stormwater; close steepest trails


Safety & Security: consider adding security camera(s)

Woodland Management:


Hazard tree removal, pruning, invasive vegetation management, vegetation protection









basketball court and 1 street hockey, with lighting

Portsmouth: 1

basketball court, with lighting

Smith: 2 basketball court, with lighting hockey with lighting

ENHANCE PARK PROGRAMMING: Courts

ENHANCE PARK PROGRAMMING: Dog park

DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS:

- CENTRALLY LOCATED ACCESSIBLE
- FENCED ENCLOSURE
- NOT LOCATED ADJACENT TO PLAYGROUND OR SCHOOL
- AT LEAST 50' FROM A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY LINE
- 5,000 SF. MINIMUM IN AREA













Boston area dog park sizes

Defilipo Park: 6,500 sf.

Richmond St: 3,300 sf.

Peters Park: 9,400 sf.

East 1 st St: 10,650 sf.

Carleton Court (SWC): 4,500 sf.

Tudor Park, Cambridge: 11,600 sf.


Mansfield St Park, Allston: 4,800 sf.




ENHANCE PARK PROGRAMMING: Dog park locations



ENHANCE PARK PROGRAMMING: Dog park locations #1: Locate dog park adjacent to Gordon St.



ENHANCE PARK PROGRAMMING: Dog park locations #2: Convert playground to dog park, relocate playground adjacent to JM school, convert little league baseball to multiuse field




ENHANCE PARK PROGRAMMING: Dog park locations #3: Convert little league baseball field to multi-use field with dog park



ENHANCE PARK PROGRAMMING: Dog park locations #4: Convert little league baseball field to multi-use field with dog park
