WHEREAS, the the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Neighborhood Development; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FIVE MILLION NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO DOLLARS (**\$5,959,142.00**) would fund the creation of affordable housing units by non-profit and for-profit developers. Therefore be it
