The Program offers three products to choose from, so participating customers can select the one that's right for them. We encourage you to visit our website and enroll in the Optional Green 100 product if you're in a financial position to do so. With the Optional Green 100 product, 100% of your electricity comes from local, renewable energy sources.
