





# Attachment A Notice of Intent Narrative

This Notice of Intent (NOI) is submitted pursuant to the requirements of the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (WPA)(MGL Chapter 131, Section 40) and its implementing regulations (310 CMR 10.00) and the requirements of the Boston Wetlands Ordinance (BWO) and associated regulations.

### 1.1 Introduction

CPC Ericsson Street, LLC (the "Proponent") is requesting that the Boston Conservation Commission (the "Commission") issue an Order of Conditions for 24 sediment sample borings (the "Project") within the existing marina at 8R Ericsson Street (the "Site"). The purpose of this activity is to evaluate the sediment that is proposed for dredging at a later date (for which a separate NOI will be filed). The sediment sampling work will temporarily impact approximately 0.6 square feet (sf) of Land Under Ocean (LUO).

# 1.2 Project Overview

Renovation of the existing marina is contemplated as part of the Neponset Wharf development project, which proposes two new residential buildings and one new mixed use (office/residential) building totaling as well as a replacement Boathouse on a 3.6-acre site along the Neponset River and Pine Neck Creek. Over 50 percent of the site will consist of landscaped outdoor space, which will significantly expand public accessibility to this unique waterfront site.

The marina at the Site has been in continuous use since 1911, although the water-side portion has been functioning at a greatly reduced capacity since it was purchased by the Proponent in 2017. Silting in the boat basin has reduced the usable area for in-water boat storage to less than half the tidal surface area. Dredging the boat basin will restore the functionality to the Site as a marina. Prior to dredging, collection of sediment samples is required for dredge spoils pre-characterization.



#### 1.3 **Site Description**

The Project Site is located in Boston's Dorchester neighborhood, and is within the Neponset River Estuary Area of Critical Environmental Concern (ACEC). The marina includes 3.73 acres of tidal and intertidal area. The boat basin is surrounded by a timber supported wall to reduce wave energy within the basin.

#### **Work Description** 1.4

Physical and chemical testing of the proposed dredged materials will be conducted in accordance with MassDEP sampling and analysis requirements (314 CMR 9.07(2)).

Vibracoring will be conducted from a vessel equipped with an A-frame or davit arm and a winch. A total of 24 vibracores (one per each 1,000 sf of proposed dredge materials) will be collected at the locations indicated on the Proposed Sampling Plan (Attachment D). The vessel will be equipped with GPS equipment to ensure each core is taken in the desired location and to record the sampling location. Based on field conditions at the time of the sampling, core locations may be adjusted as needed. The equipment will vibrate a 2-inch stainless steel or aluminum tube with an inner acrylic or polycarbonate liner into the sediment to the depth of dredging (ranging from approximately 2 to 6 feet below the existing sea floor surface). A core catcher installed in the bottom will prevent the collected sediment from slipping out as the corer is recovered. Once the desired depth is achieved, the corer will be retracted and brought onto the sampling vessel. The liner will be cut open to expose the sample for inspection and sample recovery. Samples will be collected in bottles prepared and provided by a state licensed laboratory. Excess sample material from the core will be returned to the harbor.

Work is anticipated to take place in June and/or July of 2021. The samples will be collected between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm on weekdays and/or weekends. Twenty-four-hour notification will be given to the Boston Conservation Commission prior to activity commencing. It is anticipated that the activity will require up to one week to complete.

## 1.5 Mitigation Measures

Any impacts to resource areas are expected to be negligible and temporary. All practical precautions will be used during in-water work. Should any floating debris result from the Project, the contractor will contain, collect and remove it from the Site. A quick-absorbent material, such as "Speedy Dry" or equivalent, will be readily available area at the work site and on any project related vessels for use in the event petroleum-based fluids are spilled or leaked. The contractor will have an oil sorbent boom at the Project Site and will deploy the boom immediately upon observing any petroleum sheen on the watersheet. Any equipment that uses fuel, oil or hydraulic fluid will be inspected daily for leakage.

# 1.6 Regulatory Compliance

#### 1.6.1 Land Under Ocean

The Project will impact approximately 0.6 sf of Land Under Ocean (LUO). According to 310 CMR 10.25, LUO means land extending from the mean low water (MLW) line seaward to the boundary of the municipality's jurisdiction and includes land under estuaries.

LUO is likely to be significant to the protection of marine fisheries and, where there are shellfish, to protection of land containing shellfish. Nearshore areas of LUO are likely to be significant to storm damage prevention, flood control, and protection of wildlife habitat. When LUO or nearshore areas of LUO are found to be significant to the protection of marine fisheries, protection of wildlife habitat, storm damage prevention or flood control, 310 CMR 10.25(3) through (7) shall apply:

- (3) Improvement dredging for navigational purposes affecting land under the ocean shall be designed and carried out using the best available measures so as to minimize adverse effects on such interests caused by changes in:
  - a) bottom topography which will result in increased flooding or erosion caused by an increase in the height or velocity of waves impacting the shore;
  - b) sediment transport processes which will increase flood or erosion hazards by affecting the natural replenishment of beaches;
  - c) water circulation which will result in an adverse change in flushing rate, temperature, or turbidity levels; or
  - d) marine productivity which will result from the suspension or transport of pollutants, the smothering of bottom organisms, the accumulation of pollutants by organisms, or the destruction of marine fisheries habitat or wildlife habitat.



The Project does not include dredging; therefore, this performance standard is not applicable.

(4) Maintenance dredging for navigational purposes affecting land under the ocean shall be designed and carried out using the best available measures so as to minimize adverse effects on such interests caused by changes in marine productivity which will result from the suspension or transport of pollutants, increases in turbidity, the smothering of bottom organisms, the accumulation of pollutants by organisms, or the destruction of marine fisheries habitat or wildlife habitat.

The Project does not include dredging; therefore, this performance standard is not applicable.

(5) Projects not included in 310 CMR 10.25(3) or (4) which affect nearshore areas of land under the ocean shall not cause adverse effects by altering the bottom topography so as to increase storm damage or erosion of coastal beaches, coastal banks, coastal dunes, or salt marshes.

The Project will not result in alteration of the bottom topography.

- (6) Projects not included in 310 CMR 10.25(3) which affect land under the ocean shall if water-dependent be designed and constructed, using best available measures, so as to minimize adverse effects, and if non-water-dependent, have no adverse effects, on marine fisheries habitat or wildlife habitat caused by:
  - a) alterations in water circulation;
  - b) destruction of eelgrass (Zostera marina) or widgeon grass (Rupia maritina) beds;
  - c) alterations in the distribution of sediment grain size;
  - d) changes in water quality, including, but not limited to, other than natural fluctuations in the level of dissolved oxygen, temperature or turbidity, or the addition of pollutants; or
  - e) alterations of shallow submerged lands with high densities of polychaetes, mollusks or macrophytic algae.

The sediment sampling will be conducted in such a way so as not to affect water circulation or water quality in the Neponset River Estuary. The Site does not contain eelgrass or areas with high densities of polychaetes, mollusks or macrophytic algae. There will be no change to the contour of the sea floor.

• (7) Notwithstanding the provisions of 310 CMR 10.25(3) through (6), no project may be permitted which will have any adverse effect on specified habitat sites of rare vertebrate or invertebrate species, as identified by procedures established under 310 CMR 10.37.

There are no specified habitat sites located on the Project Site; therefore, this performance standard is not applicable.

As per the Massachusetts Division of Marine Fisheries (DMF) Technical Report TR-47, Dorchester Bay and the Neponset River are subject to a Time of Year (TOY) restriction for inwater construction work from February 15 to November 15. The Project will be completed outside of the TOY restriction period.



### 1.6.2 Neponset River Estuary ACEC

The Neponset River Estuary was designated as an ACEC in 1995, and a Resource Management Plan (RMP) was approved by the EEA Secretary on May 5, 1996. The Project Site is within the reach called the lower Neponset River Estuary, which is identified as that portion of the ACEC most suitable for the continuation of water-dependent recreational uses. The RMP acknowledges and specifically endorses expansion/improvement of existing facilities and maintenance dredging activities that allow for the continued use of those spaces. Further, the RMP identifies the existing extent of the marina as an area of "previously authorized dredging." Maintenance dredging for navigational purposes may be conducted in compliance with 310 CMR 10.24(5)(b) and 10.25(4). The proposed Project is being conducted in support of this allowable activity.

### 1.6.3 Permits and Approvals

Physical and chemical testing of the proposed dredged materials will be conducted in accordance with MassDEP sampling and analysis requirements (314 CMR 9.07(2)). A Dredge Material Sampling Plan was submitted for approval by MassDEP on May 24, 2021. The Project will not commence until that plan has been approved.

The Neponset Wharf development plan is in the process of undergoing review by the BPDA and MEPA office. These agencies have reviewed an Environmental Notification Form/Project Notification Form (ENF/PNF) and a Draft Environmental Impact Report/Draft Project Impact Report (DEIR/DPIR). A Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) is currently being prepared. The results of the currently proposed sediment sampling are required for inclusion in the FIER.






