Docket #0801, message and order for annual appropriation and tax order for FY2022.

Docket #0802, message and order for annual appropriation for the School Department for FY2022.

Docket #0803, message and order approving an appropriation of Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000.00) to the Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) Liability Trust Fund.

Docket #0804, message and order approving an appropriation of Eight Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$12,600,000.00) from the City's Capital Grant Fund in order to provide funding for various transportation and public realm improvements, to be credited to the Capital Grant fund from the Parking Meter Fund.

Docket #0805, message and order approving an appropriation of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) from the City's Capital Grant Fund to address the impact of transportation network services on municipal roads, bridges, and other transportation infrastructure or any other public purpose substantially related to the operation of transportation network services in the city, to be credited to the Capital Grant Fund from the Commonwealth Transportation Infrastructure Enhancement Trust Fund.

Docket #0810, message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Fifty- Five Million Dollars (\$55,000,000.00) in the form of a grant, awarded by the United States Department of Treasury to be administered by the City of Boston's Chief Financial Officer/Collector Treasurer. This grant payment is made from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CLFRF) in the Treasury of the United States established by Section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA).

Docket #0687, message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00) in the form of a grant, awarded by the United States Department of the Treasury to be administered by the City of Boston's Chief Financial Officer/Collector Treasurer. This grant payment is made from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CLFRF) in the Treasury of the United States established by Section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA).

Docket #0725, message and order approving an increase of the cost-of-living adjustment ("COLA") base from \$14,000.00 to \$15,000.00 for all retirees and beneficiaries of the Boston Retirement System.
