The text of the proposed amendment is: **Section 3.09: Delivery:** No Licensee in the City of Boston including but not limited to recreational cannabis dispensaries, manufacturers, and cultivators, may engage in the delivery of recreational cannabis including through a licensed courier or delivery operator, without the express written permission of the BCB.
