## RFP BYRRC BIPOC LGBTQ+ Youth Mentorship Question Responses

1. Can these funds support an existing program or are they only for building new programs?
  - The funds can support either existing or new programming.
2. Can the program support BIPOC and/or LGBTQ+ youth, or is it for youth who identify as both BIPOC and LGBTQ+?
  - The program is supporting youth who identify as both BIPOC and LGBTQ+
3. Can mentors identify as allies, or do they themselves need to be BIPOC LGBTQ+?
  - Mentors can identify as allies, however the BYRRC project team strongly prefers that agencies are able to recruit BIPOC LGBTQ+ mentors for the youth. BYRRC project team will support the agency in recruitment.
4. Can the two events required in the RFP invite those who identify as allies as well, or do they need to be only for BIPOC LGBTQ+ identified youth?
  - The events can be open to allies, however the events must be tailored to BIPOC LGBTQ+ identified youth.
5. Can potential newcomers to your agency apply?
  - The RFP is open to anyone who fits the requirement. Previous engagement with BPHC is not requirement.
6. Can you confirm the deadline to send in proposal is August 5, 2022?
  - Yes, the deadline is August 5, 2022 unless expanded if no suitable candidate is identified.
7. What are the proposal requirements?
  - The proposal requirements are as listed in the RFP.
