The Boston City Council's Committee on Public Health, Homelessness and Recovery will hold a public hearing on Thursday, December 1, 2022 at 10:00 AM. This hearing will take place in the Iannella Chamber, fifth floor, Boston City Hall.

The subject of the hearing is:

<u>Docket #1033</u> – Order for a hearing to address the humanitarian crisis at the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Melnea Cass Boulevard and Section 35 as a treatment option.

This matter is sponsored by Councilor Erin Murphy and Councilor Frank Baker and was referred to the Committee on Public Health, Homelessness and Recovery on August 31, 2022.
