



One of 3 Priority Projects Fenway-Longwood Kenmore Transportation Action Plan (2009)

Goals for Boylston Street:

- Tree-lined pedestrian friendly boulevard with place-making at Jersey St and Kilmarnock St
- Wide sidewalks and bicycle lanes
- Maintain effective traffic flow
- Establish the Boylston St/Brookline Ave intersection as a gateway



75% of the sidewalks (yellow areas) have been reconstructed or are planned for reconstruction by developers. Parcel F is in the planning stages.





Quick-build bike lanes were added in 2022













Boylston St: Short Term Improvements (2022)



Boylston St: Short Term Improvements (2022)



A state funded "TIP" project that previously ended at Brookline Ave was expanded to include land owned by DCR. The expanded project includes:

- Protected bike lanes through the Muddy River crossing owned by DCR
- Upgraded signals for more pedestrian friendly signal timings
- Ramp upgrades
- Curb extensions for shorter crossings
- Better bike connections to the Fenway Path and the Longwood Medical Area

The TIP Project is scheduled for construction in 2024/2025
