MILLENNIUM PARK CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FEBRUARY, 2023

Thank you for your continued interest in the Millennium Park construction project and for your patience.

Boston Parks understands Millennium Park is a major recreational part of the West Roxbury community and we continue to strive to reduce impacts during construction. Boston Parks also recognizes having a well-loved playground closed to the public for such a long duration is challenging. We appreciate your patience during the renovation of this amazing park.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN FEBRUARY:

- **Phase 1: Playground**
 - The playground equipment has arrived and our contractor has begun the installation! Winter is never an ideal time for installation due to weather conditions, however the next few weeks look favorable for assembling the play structures. We hope you are as excited as we are to see this community and youth-led playground design unfold.
- **Phase 3 Upper parking lot, pedestrian pathways and urban wild design work continues.**
 - Our team continues to move forward on the design of the next phase of paving and the urban wilds work. The scope of this phase includes improvements to the upper parking lot, access road, pathways, erosion control, and Urban Wilds invasive species management, tree health, signage and entrance improvements.



ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION TIMELINES

- Late Spring 2023: Playground completion
- Mid-summer 2023: Upper parking lot (completion by September)
- Fall 2023: Pedestrian pathways and urban wild work
- Bathroom facility: TBD
