April 20, 2023

TIME 5:02 PM: Chair M. Kiefer called the public hearing to order. He explained that, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Order suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law, that the public hearing was being conducted virtually via the online meeting platform Zoom in order to review Design Review applications. He also briefly explained how to participate in the online hearing.

Following this brief introduction he called the first design review application.

I. VIOLATIONS



Applicant: Eleanor Lawrence Proposed work: Ratification of unapproved window replacements, unapproved door hardware, unapproved ring doorbell.

PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE: Eleanor Lawrence

DOCUMENTS PRESENTED: Photos of existing conditions, plans, and details for the proposed work.

DISCUSSION TOPICS: The timeline of the work that has been done as well as the proper process for approval for future work. Requested using a brass plate to cover the doorbell and that the whole fixture be recessed; that the keypad is also covered with a brass plate. They also explained that wood windows with true divided lights





and dark spacer bars are more consistent with the district's guidelines and that the existing windows must be replaced. No building permit was obtained for this work.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Richelle Gewertz, Beacon Hill Civic Association (BHCA), recommended that the violations were ratified in a timely manner.

COMMISSIONER M KIEFER MOTIONED TO RATIFY THE VIOLATIONS WITH PROVISOS. COMMISSIONER A RICHMOND SECONDED THE MOTION. THE VOTE WAS 8-0-1 (YES: AA, MF, MK, EF, RJ, CK, AR, WW) (NO: NONE) (ABSTAIN/ABSENT: AG).

- The Commission requires that the remedy of these violations with the following guidance;
 - Requiring the applicant to make a formal application for each of the items that have been cited for the remedy for each of the items that have been cited.
 - That the violations are remedied within 60 days.
 - The windows replaced without the approval of the Commission will be replaced with windows that conform to the district standards.
 - That a brass cover will be installed over both the key fob and the ring doorbell.
 - That the ring doorbell will be installed to the left of the pilaster and that any existing holes will be repaired.

DISCUSSION TOPICS: The appropriateness of the proposed brass plate to cover the doorbell and its location.


PUBLIC COMMENT: Richelle Gewertz, BHCA, supported the application and asked the applicant to minimize illumination.



DISCUSSION TOPICS: The reason the deck is positioned so closely to the edge of the structure, the height of the deck, whether the deck was approved previously, the design of the rail in comparison to neighboring decks.

- Wood privacy screen is denied without prejudice; the applicant is to return to the commission with revised designs that refine the transition between the cornice and the roofdeck.


DISCUSSION TOPICS: Placement of the numbers on the door, appropriateness of the proposed font and finish.



non-historic windows with 1 over 1, wood, windows.


APP # 23.0835 BH <u>58 BEACON STREET:</u> Repaint existing stone at first floor level and trim in kind (Rockport Grey HC 105), apply epoxy coating to stairs. (See Additional Items Under Design Review).

APP # 23.0836 BH <u>19 BRIMMER STREET (#3):</u> At level three (4th floor) replace three, non-historic, double hung, wood, 6 over 6 windows, with three, double hung, wood, 6 over 6, true divided light windows

APP # 23.0687 BH <u>78 CHARLES STREET</u>: Repoint horizontal masonry cracks above the second and third floor windows. New mortar to match existing mortar in color and aggregate. Scrape, prime and paint rear ground floor door at 78 Charles Street (aka 71 River Street). New paint, Ben Moore HC-190, Semi Gloss.

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APP # 23.0713 BH <u>**76 CHESTNUT STREET:**</u> At front facade, dormer level, replace one, 8 over 8, double hung, wood, non-historic window with one, 8 over 8, wood, double hung, window. Remove faulty storm window.

APP # 23.0827 BH <u>83 PHILLIPS STREET:</u> Repair glazing on three windows at ground level, two on 1st level and three windows on second level and repaint in current color. No new material except for the glazing compound will be used.

APP # 23.0825 BH <u>**21 SOUTH RUSSELL STREET (ADJACENT):**</u> Install two tree guards; style #1 in pre-approved designs.

APP # 23.0816 BH <u>**38 SOUTH RUSSELL STREET:**</u> Repoint and/or repair poor conditions areas in the façade from where the water is actively infiltrating into the Unit #5.
