Commission Advisory Board meetings are open to the public. Everyone interested in issues affecting the disability community in Boston is welcome to attend.

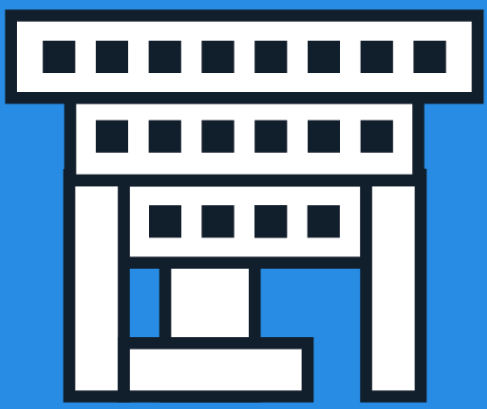
Meetings are held once a month on Wednesdays from 5:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.
