


Bus Riders on Blue Hill Avenue

Blue Hill Avenue serves 10 different bus routes. Of these bus riders:

- 56% are from low-income households
- 85% consider themselves a racial or ethnic minority
- 52% do not have access to a car
- 96% walk or bike to reach the bus






4. Short Term Improvements to DCR Signals in Mattapan Square

We are working on a plan with DCR to:

- Repair the pedestrian lights and bring them up to code
- Fix the pedestrian push buttons; add audible signals (APS)
- Make Cummins Highway a one-stage crossing if possible; if not, create a pedestrian refuge area






How Will the Decision on the Final Locations of the RISE Sculptures Be Made?

- Residents who created the vision for the gateway and worked to make it happen, and other community members
- Mayor's Office of Arts and Culture
- BTD, BPDA, MBTA, and DCR



How will the Decision on the Bus Lanes, Bike Lanes, Parking, and Trees in Mattapan Square be Made?

- Feedback collected through this process will be foundational in informing the final decision, along with recommendations from BTD, BPDA, MBTA, and DCR.
- The decision on the Mattapan Square design will be made by city leadership in consultation with local elected officials at the same time that a decision is made for the rest of the Blue Hill Ave corridor.
- A full and detailed summary of community feedback will made publicly available to both decision-makers and the public as part of the decision-making process.








