## CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove twenty eight (28) public shade trees in the vicinity of 244-284 A Street in South Boston.

Nitsch Engineering on behalf of Related Beal and Channelside Acquisitions, LLC is requesting the removal of twenty eight (28) trees surrounding the proposed project site of $244-284$ A Street in South Boston. On Binford Street there are five Sweetgum trees measuring 4" dbh (diameter at breast height); six Oak trees measuring 2.5 " dbh; and six Elm Trees measuring $2.5 " \mathrm{dbh}$. On A Street, there are five Honey Locust trees measuring $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ dbh; and six Honey Locust trees measuring 3 " dbh.
