BACK BAY ARCHITECTURAL COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING/ MEETING MINUTES

Held virtually via Zoom

April 12, 2023

<u>5:04 PM</u>: Commissioner Kathleen Connor called the public hearing to order. She explained that, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, that the public hearing was being conducted virtually via the online meeting platform Zoom in order to review Design Review applications. She also briefly explained how to participate in the online hearing.

Following this brief introduction she called the first Design Review application.

I. DESIGN REVIEW

ADDRESS: 216 Newbury Street

Applicant: Joseph McCarthy

Proposed Work: At rear elevation create masonry opening and install a six (6") inch by eight (8") inch diffuser vent.

The applicant failed to appear.

APP # 23.0744 BB ADDRESS: 44-46 Newbury Street

Applicant: Julie Reker

Proposed Work: At Newbury Street Façade redesign entrance. Work includes installing granite ramp and entry steps, converting existing window into an entry door with sidelights, replacing a set of entry doors with single door with sidelights, and adding plaque with address; and at roof replace HVAC equipment.

Project Representative: Julie Reker was the project representative.

The Commissioners reviewed a presentation consisting of photos of existing conditions and plans for the proposed work.

Discussion Topics: The Commissioners discussed the appropriate design of the front entrance area - the appropriate design and separation of the steps, the number and

placement of railings, and the design of the ramp.

Public Comment: Serge Savard, Neighborhood Association of the Back Bay (NABB), supported painting the equipment on the roof and expressed concern about the corner of the building and cutting people off from getting close to the storefront windows. Sue Prindle, NABB, encouraged the applicant to explore options to soften the corner of the building and to reduce the scale of the granite elements to compliment the lighter scale of the building's existing elements, and preserve the openness of the streetscape. Laurie Thomas, Garden Club of the Back Bay, supported adding planters to the front entrance.

Commissioner R Weintraub motioned to continue the application. Commissioner I Demetriades seconded the motion. The vote was 9-0 (Y: ACP, JC, KC, ID, ZG, TH, EM, DS, RW) (N: None).

Applicant: Rebecca Marston

Proposed Work: At rear yard remove dead Ailanthus tree.

Project Representative: Rebecca Marston was the project representative.

The Commissioners reviewed a presentation consisting of photos of existing conditions and recommendations from the Garden Club of the Back Bay.

Discussion Topics: The Commissioners discussed the appropriateness of planting a replacement tree at the front garden of this property.

Public Comment: Laurie Thomas, Back Bay Garden Club, supported planting a replacement tree in the front garden; she also expressed interest in working with the applicant to examine the other plants in the front garden that may be impacted by the new tree.

Commissioner T High motioned to approve the application with provisos. Commissioner J. Christiansen seconded the motion. The vote was 9-0 (Y: ACP, JC, KC, ID, ZG, TH, EM, DS, RW) (N: None).

Proposed Work: Amend application 23.0640 BB approved on 3-8-2023 to relocate existing door surround at lower entry to approved upper entry door.

Discussion Topics: The Commissioners discussed the placement of the door surround.

Public Comment: Alice Murphy, neighbor, supported the application but asked the applicant to consider the relationship of the balustrade to the rest of the front facade. Laurie Thomas, Garden Club of the Back Bay, asked the applicant to reconsider the design of the balustrade and window.

Commissioner J Christiansen motioned to approve the application with provisos. Commissioner I Demetriades seconded the motion. The vote was 9-0 (Y: ACP, JC, KC, ID, ZG, TH, EM, DS, RW) (N: None).


ADDRESS: 14 Hereford Street

Discussion Topics: The Commissioners discussed the location and material of the proposed vent.

Public Comment: Alice Murphy, neighbor, supported the application.

ADDRESS: 251 Commonwealth Avenue

Applicant: Ron Payne

Proposed Work: Install new rubber roof and new copper gutters and downspouts; wood window replacement in-kind including curved sash at front and rear bays; masonry re-pointing; removal of rear fire escape; new brick paving at front entry and rear yard; new courtyard masonry garden walls; install low profile pyramidal skylight, copper clad elevator override and roof top air conditioning condensers.

Project Representative: Ron Payne was the project representative.

The Commissioners reviewed a presentation consisting of photos of existing conditions and plans for the proposed work.

Discussion Topics: The Commissioners agreed that the project be approved as submitted.



The Commissioners reviewed a presentation consisting of photos of existing conditions and





plans for the proposed work.

Discussion Topics: The Commissioners encouraged the applicant to simplify the front facade by minimizing the band design and using more glass. They also discussed the design of the decorative crown and the placement of the signage.

Public Comment: Serge Savard, NABB, encouraged the applicant to lighten up the front facade and to simplify the design of the decorative crown; he also questioned the appropriateness of the proposed lighting. Sue Prindle, NABB, encouraged the applicant to bring a streetscape rendering in order to see the proposed design in the context of surrounding buildings when they return to the commission.
