## BAY STATE ROAD/BACK BAY WEST AREA ARCHITECTURAL CONSERVATION DISTRICT COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

Held virtually via Zoom

## May 10, 2022

**5:00 PM**: Commissioner Beale called the public hearing to order. **22.1080 BSR <u>587 Beacon Street:</u>** Replace existing light pole and install DAS node.

**Discussion Topics:** Commissioners discussed the fact that the proposed DAS node is different from those previously approved by the Commission in the district, specifically in that instead of a base for equipment, equipment is mounted on the shaft of the pole.
