

Request for Proposal and Quote Harm Reduction Supplies

#### Overview

The Boston Public Health Commission (BPHC) is the local public health department for the City of Boston. BPHC's mission is to protect, preserve, and promote the health and well-being of all Boston residents, particularly the most vulnerable. In fulfillment of its mission, the Commission works collaboratively with area hospitals, community health centers and community-based organizations to foster access to health services for the culturally and economically diverse communities of Boston.

BPHC is seeking qualified, responsible, and reliable vendor(s) to provide HIV and harm reduction supplies and materials at competitive market prices for the Syringe Access Program and Drug User Health Initiatives. The Program provides outreach, education, and safe injection supplies to reduce HIV and viral Hepatitis transmission and overdose death among injection drug users. The annual expenditure on supplies is approximately in the range of \$1 million.

Vendor(s) must have a UEI Number no Active Exclusions in the System of Award Management (SAM.gov) database for the duration of any contracts awarded.

Service contracts awarded by the Boston Public Health Commission may be subject to following the City of Boston's living wage ordinance. This ordinance requires that all employees working on sizable city contracts earn an hourly wage that is enough for a family of four to live at or above the federal poverty level. BPHC will consider and encourage Certified Unrepresentative Businesses Enterprises(CUBE) that includes; Minority-owned Business Enterprises (MBE), Women-owned Business Enterprises (WBE), Veteran-owned Business Enterprises (VBE), Disability-owned Business Enterprise (DOBE), Lesbian Gay Bisexual Transgender Business Enterprises (LGBTBE), Minority Non Profit(MNPO), Women Non Profit(WNPO), Minority Women Non Profit(MWNPO) and local businesses to apply to this RFP. #### Scope of Work

The selected vendors will be responsible for supplying the specified items as outlined in the "Items and Cost Sheet." Vendors shall respond in a timely manner to all requests via email or telephone to provide quotes that includes quote number, prices (per unit), quantities, detailed item description, and delivery fees for the harm reduction item. Supplies will be ordered on an as-needed basis, with stock levels reviewed regularly to determine reorder needs.

### Vendor Selection and Contracting

BPHC anticipates awarding contracts to several vendors to fulfill the various items listed in this RFP. Vendors will be selected based on their ability to provide competitive pricing, quality products, and reliable service. By contracting with multiple vendors, we aim to ensure the consistent availability of supplies and mitigate risks associated with supply chain disruptions.

#### Cancellation and Withdrawal

BPHC may cancel this RFP and/or reject any proposal prior to award. In such cases, BPHC will provide vendors with a notice of cancellation.

Vendors may withdraw their proposal by June 20, 2024, at 5pm. Vendors cannot resubmit withdrawn proposal after this deadline. Vendors must submit their notice of withdrawal in writing to <u>RFR@bphc.org</u>.

#### Period Of Performance

The anticipated start date of services will be on or about July 1, 2024. The initial contract term will be for one year ending June 30, 2025, with the option to extend 2 additional years (this will be on the discretion of BPHC).

#### Submission Instructions

Vendor(s) must submit proposal in the following order:

- 1. A brief introduction of the business, and a comprehensive delivery plan to support the items listed on the "Item and Cost Sheet" including estimated lead times and shipping inclusive.
  - a. Proposal must not exceed 2 pages and must be in format (12-point Times New Romen, Calibri, or Arial font)

- 2. Within the proposal, identify areas that can support discount of items.
- 3. Business Profile (page 4)
- 4. Vendor Business Reference (Page 5)
- 5. Item and Cost Sheet (contains 3 pages)

Submit all documents in one PDF format file to <u>RFR@bphc.org</u> by 5:00 PM on June 17, 2024, with subject line format "Company Name – Proposal for Harm Reduction Supplies".

Vendor(s) shall not alter any forms within this RFP. However, pages can be extracted to be included in your proposal.
