**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND** FY24 Hazmat Grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY Massachusetts Department of Fire Services.

**WHEREAS**, the Massachusetts Department of Fire Services, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds in the amount of ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND FOURTEEN DOLLARS AND TWENTY CENTS (**\$1,604,014.20**) would fund the needs of the hazardous materials response teams, as specified in line item 8324-0000 and 8324-0050 of the FY24 General Appropriations Act.
