Thank you for your interest in the Improvements to Harambee Park Phase 4 project.

GENERAL UPDATES:

- Phase 4 includes two new cricket fields – one is a competition field with field lighting and an electric scoreboard, the other is a practice field.
- Construction is anticipated to be completed in the fall of 2024. The fields will require additional time for the establishment of the turf and will remain closed until spring 2025.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

- The lighting and scoreboard have been installed at the competition cricket field.
- Pedestrian light poles have been installed along the outer walkway.
- The asphalt base course has been installed at the pathways.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- During construction the access from the end of Westview Street to Talbot Ave. will be closed off. When coming from Westview Street, enter the park near the football field (across from Westview Way) and take the path through to Talbot Ave. From Talbot Ave. enter the park near the playground (across from Wales Street) and take the path through to Westview Street.
