# HARVARD CHABAD Longwood Medical Area Student and Hospitality Center

1617 – 1615 Tremont Street, Boston


- The revised building mass provides an additional setback for the entire facade along Tremont an additional 5'-6" from Tremont Street sidewalk to directly address comments that increase the front yard setback and provides a landscape buffer from the sidewalk along Tremont Street.
- To directly respond to building mass concerns raised by staff, the current proposal reflects moving the east wall of building mass in by an additional 2'-0" to narrow the massing, widen the width of the front yard of 1615, and creates spatial and visual relief between the two buildings.
- BLC staff suggested the design incorporate a vegetated landscape and ornamental fence consistent with neighborhood examples to better relate to the Tremont Street rowhouses. This design consideration was explored and accepted by the applicant's architect. The current proposal reflects an ornamental metal fence in front of a deeper front yard setback of Tremont Street sidewalk.
- To directly address issues raised regarding the visibility of the elevator from Wigglesworth the current proposal revises the location of the elevator to be further away from Wigglesworth to greatly reduce visibility from the sidewalk.
- The north side of the fourth-floor roof is revised to a hipped roof and dormer configuration along the alley façade to reduce scale and minimize the visibility from the sidewalk.
- To directly address issues raised regarding the window alignments and sizes, the current proposal has revised the size, proportion, and location of window heads, sills, and mullions to reflect adjacent datums with rowhouses along Tremont Street. In addition to window locations, the masonry detailing has been revised to reflect masonry headers and sills that pick up on the pronounced architectural window surrounds.

# Design Revisions JULY 19, 2024

- The entire building mass is setback an additional **5' 6"** from Tremont Street to increase the front yard setback and landscape buffer from the sidewalk along Tremont Street.
- Relocated the east wall of building mass an additional **2'-0"** to narrow the massing, widen the width of front yard of 1615, and create spatial and visual relief between the two facades.
































