LEAF AND YARD WASTE COMPOSTING

Drop off your leaf and yard waste on scheduled days, drop-off events, or curbside collection with your trash day. Learn more at boston.gov/yard-waste

- Place leaves and yard waste in large paper bags or open barrels labeled “yard waste”
- Branches should be no more than 3 feet long, 1 inch thick, and tied with a string.
- Please no plastic bags or dirt.
- We collect Christmas trees curbside from December 30, 2024 - January 10, 2025



TEXTILE RECOVERY

Recycle your textiles at our drop-off locations or schedule a curbside pick-up with our partners at Helpsy. Please make sure that all clothing items are clean, dry, and odorless. Learn more at boston.gov/textiles



ZERO WASTE DAY* DROP-OFFS

Drop off your household hazardous waste materials and certain waste ban items at our collection events throughout the year. The City of Boston hosts several Zero Waste Days that accept the following: car tires and batteries, household materials, kitchen and laundry materials, all paint, textiles and clothing, batteries, lightbulbs, electronics, and paper shredding. FOOD WASTE COMPOSTING

Sign up free curbside food waste collection or find your closest food waste drop-off location. Learn more at boston.gov/food-waste



TRASH COLLECTION

Trash must be placed curbside by 6 a.m. on your scheduled collection day, or after 5 p.m. the night before. Furniture is accepted curbside. The City will not collect any construction debris or materials from businesses. Learn more at boston.gov/trash-and-recycling



SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING

Place metal, glass, paper, plastic, and cardboard items curbside by 6 a.m. on your scheduled collection day, or after 5 p.m. the night before. Search the directory on the Trash Day App to find out the right way to dispose of unwanted items. Please clean items before recycling them.

We do not accept any kind of plastic bag or styrofoam in the curbside recycling program. Learn more at boston.gov/recycling



SPECIAL ITEM COLLECTION

Dial 3-1-1 or visit boston.gov/311 to schedule appliance collection for:

- televisions,
- air conditioners,
- refrigerators,
- freezers,
- water coolers,
- dehumidifiers,
- computer monitors



MATTRESS COLLECTION

MassDEP requires that mattresses are recycled. You must schedule an appointment for curbside collection of your mattress or box spring. Futons and other similar non-mattress items are still accepted in the regular curbside trash collection. This program does not service buildings with seven units or more. Ask your property manager about recycling mattresses in your building.
