AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND MassEVIP Charging Stations FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs.

WHEREAS, the MA Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Transportation Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX DOLLARS (**\$539,256.00**) would fund sixty (60) electric vehicle charging station(s) under the Massachusetts Electric Vehicle Incentive Program (MassEVIP) Public Access Charging (PAC) Program. Therefore be it
