**WHEREAS**, the MA Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Transportation Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$539,256.00) would fund sixty (60) electric vehicle charging station(s) under the Massachusetts Electric Vehicle Incentive Program (MassEVIP) Public Access Charging (PAC) Program. Therefore be it
