She explained that, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, that the public hearing was being conducted virtually via the online meeting platform Zoom in order to review Design Review applications. DISCUSSION TOPICS (BRIEF): Visibility of the unit, ability to screen the unit, existing vegetation, alternate locations.

- That if the front row of shrubs are able to be maintained so as to shield the electrical transformer from view, they should be. Otherwise, a fence or trellis should be designed to enclose the transformer as much as possible and shield it from view from the street. If this option is chosen, the Commission asked to explore planting a vine plant such as ivy that would be able to grow up the fencing/trellis and reduce the transformers visibility.
