About the Boston CHNA Survey

The Boston Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) is a comprehensive effort to identify the strengths, challenges, and public health priorities for the city of Boston. This process is led by the <u>Boston Community Health Collaborative</u>, a multi-sector collaboration of Boston nonprofit teaching hospitals, community health centers, community organizations, and public health.

The community health survey asks residents about their community health priorities, access to care, and availability of resources to support their physical and mental health and well-being. By taking this quick, confidential survey, you'll help guide health initiatives in our community and contribute towards making Boston a healthier city for all.

Who can take the survey and how long will it be available?

- Residents of Boston age 14+ can take the survey.
- This year, the community health survey will include a raffle for prizes, including two \$100 grocery gift cards, museum passes, family-friendly experiences and more.

• The survey will be available until early December 2024.

Social Media Alt Text

Alternative text, or Alt text, is a written description of an image or other visual element in a digital document, such as a PDF or a social media post.

It is used to make visual content accessible to people who have visual impairments or use assistive technologies, such as screen readers.
