253 Summer Street Life is Good Window Scrim Project

Description of Proposed Work

- 1. **Removal of Decorative Wrought Iron Fixtures:** Life is Good proposes removing the existing decorative wrought iron fixtures currently installed on the exterior facade of the retail space windows. These fixtures are only present on six windows and are not found on the other windows along Melcher Street. By removing the wrought iron, they will achieve a consistent and cohesive appearance that aligns with the rest of the building's facade.
- 2. **Replacement of Opaque White Film and Installation of Window Scrims:** The windows of the former retail space are currently covered with an opaque white film. Life is Good proposes replacing this film with custom-designed window scrims that reflect the Life is Good brand and enhance the visual appeal of 253 Summer Street's exterior. These scrims will be applied to the interior side of the windows, preserving the original window frames and the architectural integrity of the historic building. The same treatment will be applied to the windows on the retail space door, ensuring a uniform and branded look across the entire facade. There is no illumination associated with this project.


- 1. Life is Good plans to use CG Sign and Graphic Services (60 Morse Place, New Haven CT) for the production and installation of the window scrims. They have not yet identified which General Contractor / Mason will be used to remove the wrought iron fixtures.
- 2. The scrims will be made of perforated vinyl.
- 3. CG Sign and Graphic Services quoted Life is Good approximately \$7000.00 for the job.

- Vendor is CG Sign and Graphic Services












Current view of windows featuring decorative wrought iron fixtures
