Public Hearing

- PH 1. On a joint petition by the City of Boston Transportation Department and the City of Boston Public Works Department for the making of **Specific Repairs** within the following public ways in Boston Proper, consisting of curb realignment, roadway and sidewalk reconstruction, as well as new and relocated pedestrian ramps, specialty pavement, street lighting infrastructure, traffic signal infrastructure, stormdrain infrastructure, driveway curb cuts, median islands, and raised crosswalks:
 - **Tremont Street** generally between Marginal Road and Charles Street South/Jefferson Street;
 - Charles Street South generally between Melrose Street and Tremont Street/Jefferson Street:
 - Marginal Road at Tremont Street;
 - Church Street northwest of Tremont Street:
 - Jefferson Street northwest of Tremont Street/Charles Street South;
 - Fayette Street west of Charles Street South;
 - Warrenton Street east of Charles Street South;
 - Melrose Street west of Charles Street South.

- **Dorrance South** southwest of Arlington Avenue;
- Beacham Street generally between Arlington Avenue and Main Street;
- West Street generally at Beacham Street.
