Thank you for forwarding the Civilian Review Board's findings and recommendations regarding CRB Complaint #395, which involved the actions of Sergeant Michael Aziz. The Department acknowledges receipt of the report and the Board's determinations.

The CRB issued the following findings:

BPD Rule 102§3 (Conduct): *Sustained*

BPD Rule 102§4 (Neglect of Duty): *Unable to Reach a Finding*

The CRB recommended that Sergeant Aziz receive an Oral Reprimand for the sustained violation of Rule 102§3 (Conduct).

In accordance with established Department protocol, this matter has been referred to the Internal Affairs Division for further review. IAD will assess the findings and recommended discipline to determine whether the Department concurs and whether additional investigation or action is warranted.

To facilitate a timely and complete review, we respectfully request that your office provide all evidentiary materials relied upon in making its findings, including but not limited to witness statements, body-worn camera footage, interview summaries, and documentary exhibits to the attention of Superintendent Richard Dahill..

We appreciate your continued cooperation and commitment to promoting accountability and transparency in police oversight. Please do not hesitate to reach out if additional coordination is needed during the Department's internal review.
