6:00 PM: Acting Chair A. Shelburne called the public hearing to order. He explained that, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, that the public hearing was being conducted virtually via the online meeting platform Zoom in order to review Design Review applications. Discussion Topics: The Commissioners discussed the plan to retain the existing roof structure and noted inconsistencies in the drafting of the plans.

A landscape plan with plantings must be submitted to staff for review and approval. Staff must review the progress of construction to ensure construction work follows approved drawings.


Applicant: Jonathan Tung

Proposed Work: Construct two-story addition to existing two-story house.

Project Representatives: Michael Chavez, Bruce McLay and Jonathan Tung **Documents Presented:** The Commissioners reviewed a presentation consisting of photos of existing conditions, plans, and drawings for the proposed work.

Discussion Topics: The Commissioners discussed the number of trees proposed for removal, the details of the new landscape plan, and the height of the addition's roof and its connection to the existing house. They questioned the appropriateness of replicating Page 2 of 3

the window details of the existing house on the new addition, and discussed siding options.

Public Comment: Alison Pultinas asked for more information about the species of existing and proposed trees.

COMMISSIONER S. GAJERE MOTIONED TO CONTINUE THE REVIEW OF THE APPLICATION. COMMISSIONER A. WARD HYATT SECONDED THE MOTION. THE VOTE WAS 4-1-0 (Y: AS, EC, CBM, AWH) (N: AC) (ABS: NONE).

• The Commission has continued this hearing and requests: further revisions to the roof detail where the addition meets the existing house; revisions to the proposed windows to not replicate the trim details of the existing house on the windows of the proposed addition; revisions to the proposed siding to break-up the addition's massing and to relate to the siding of the house; and a more developed landscape plan that specifies what trees will be removed, and what species trees will be planted as replacements.

J. Cornish reported that interviews for the vacant preservation planner position, and HPACDC commissioners are ongoing A. Shelburne requested that staff distribute the draft HPACDC Bylaws with his comments to commissioners.
