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CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove three (3) public shade trees at **151 Cambridge St, Downtown.**

The request is for the removal of three (3) public shade trees in order to accommodate the demolition of the existing West End branch of the Boston Public Library and the redevelopment of the parcel which includes 119-units of affordable housing and a new, two-story, West End Boston Public Library branch. The following trees are being requested for removal. Three (3) Linden trees measuring 20 inches DBH (diameter at breast height), 20 inches DBH and 21 Inches DBH.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) remotely on **Thursday, September 11, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. Via ZOOM.**
