The Boston City Council's Committee on Veterans, Military Families, and Military Affairs will hold a hearing on Friday, November 21, 2025 at 10:00 am in the Iannella Chamber, 5th Floor, Boston City Hall.

The subjects of the hearing are:

Docket #0253, Order for a hearing to discuss the goals and priorities of the City of Boston's Office of Veteran Services.

This matter was sponsored by Councilors Edward M. Flynn and Erin J. Murphy, and was referred to the Committee on January 15, 2025.

Docket #0722, Message and order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$12,881.00) in the form of a grant, for the Jobs for Veterans' State Grant, awarded by the United States Department of Labor, passed through the United States Department of Career Services, to be administered by the Office of Workforce Development. The grant will fund enhanced employment services for eligible veterans, prioritizing disabled veterans, and those facing significant barriers to employment, with the goal of improving their job search outcomes and economic self-sufficiency.

This matter was sponsored by Mayor Michelle Wu, and was referred to the Committee on April 2, 2025.
