TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Dear Councilors:

I transmit herewith a supplemental appropriation order for the Boston Public Schools Department for FY26 in the amount of One Million, Forty-Six Thousand, One Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$1,046,178.00) to cover the FY26 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the School Committee of the City of Boston and the United Steelworkers 2936 (Bus Monitors). The terms of the contracts are July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2028. The major provisions of the contracts include base wage increases of 2% to be given in July of each fiscal year of the contract term, as well as a \$1/hr flat increase in January 2026 and a \$0.70/hr flat increase (for assigned monitors only) in Jan 2028.

I respectfully request your support of this supplemental appropriation.

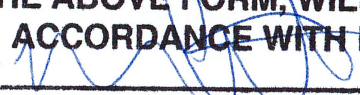
AN ORDER APPROPRIATING ONE MILLION, FORTY SIX THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$1,046,178) TO COVER THE FY26 COST ITEMS CONTAINED WITHIN THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE BOSTON SCHOOL COMMITTEE AND THE UNITED STEELWORKERS 2936 (BUS MONITORS).

ORDERED: That in addition to the appropriations heretofore made, to meet the current operating expenses of the fiscal period commencing July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026, the sum of ONE MILLION, FORTY SIX THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$1,046,178) be, and the same hereby is appropriated as follows, said sum to be met from available funds and taxation pursuant to Section 23 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws: -
