No Violation

Notice: Failure to cooperate with police in violation of M.G.L. ch. 138 s. 64 and Board's rule 1.10 A+B.

Violation - Suspension to be deemed served by the Licensee's voluntary closure since August 3

Prior to reopening, the Board will require the Licensee to have a written security, operations, and dispersal plan approved by the Boston Police Department.

Upon reopening, the Licensee's closing hour will be rolled back to 9:30 PM (all patrons off the premise by 10:00 PM) for a period of 90 days. Prior to the end of this probationary period, the Licensee will appear at a hearing before to brief the Board on their security, operations, and dispersal plan. This plan must be approved by the Board before the hours rollback will be lifted.

Additionally, the Licensee must provide evidence to the Board that management and staff have

been trained on management, security, and deescalation. This training must also occur before the hours rollback will be lifted.

(Separately, the Entertainment Division of the Mayor's Office of Consumer Affairs and Licensing will suspend the Licensee's live entertainment license for a period of 90 days, to run concurrently with the hours rollback. For this period, the Licensee may only have non-live entertainment consisting of background music and televisions. The Entertainment Division will also schedule an informational hearing to be briefed on the Licensee's safe operation of entertainment prior to the reinstatement of the live entertainment license.)
