I transmit herewith for your approval an order appropriating four million, four hundred thousand dollars (\$4,400,000) from the income of the 21st Century Fund, also known as the Public, Educational or Governmental (PEG) Access and Cable Related Fund.

Pursuant to Section 53F 3/4 of Chapter 44 of the General Laws the funds may be used to support PEG access services, to monitor compliance with the cable franchise agreement, and for preparation of renewal of the franchise license.

That the sum of four million, four hundred thousand dollars (\$4,400,000) be and the same hereby is appropriated as follows, said sum to be met from available funds in the PEG Access and Cable Related Fund pursuant to Section 53F3/4 of Chapter 44 of the General Laws and the same hereby is appropriated to the PEG Access and Cable Related Grant for cable related purposes consistent with the franchise agreement between the cable operator and the city, including , but not limited to: (i) supporting public, educational or governmental access cable television services; (ii) monitoring compliance of cable operator with franchise agreement; or (iii) preparation of renewal of the franchise license.
