

That the vote of this Commission at its meeting of July 20, 2016 and, thereafter, amended by PFD's Director under a delegation of authority to increase the additional services on June 5, 2017 regarding a contract with Weston & Sampson Engineers, Inc. to provide architectural and engineering design and construction administration services associated with the South End Fitness Center Pool Improvements project located at 35 Northampton Street, Boston, MA:

By deleting the following words and figures: "at a cost not to exceed \$119,760, including \$44,760 for additional services, which is a fixed fee of 10% based on an estimated construction cost of \$750,000" and substituting in place thereof the following figures: "at a cost not to exceed \$159,760,



including \$59,760 for additional services, which is a fixed fee of 8.3% based on an estimated construction cost of \$1,200,000."
