



#### PETERS PARK GOALS

#### **PARK TIMELINE**




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

















Drainage problem exists along sections of the walkway






## Circulation Analysis Peters Park

Along the western edge of the passive walkway, the area under the tree canopy contains exposed tree roots, and lacks groundcover/vegetation








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


Along the western edge of the passive walkway, the area under the tree canopy contains exposed tree roots and lacks established groundcover/vegetation






View looking west towards the passive walking area

Lawn is well worn between the allée of trees along the northern property line








A desire path contains many exposed tree roots and no lawn along the outside of the baseball field fence.

How can these under used, interstitial spaces be better?










view looking south from sidewalk along Washington St

What can the Friends contribute to make these spaces thrive?







#### **Existing Fencing** Peters Park

View looking west




Pedestrians are free to create their own path to enter the park along the southern boundary

With no fence along Bradford Street, desire paths link the street sidewalk to the park's interior. Lawn is patchy or even absent from the foot traffic within these sections






