**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND BRA Grant Agreement FUNDS, AWARDED BY Boston Redevelopment Authority.**

**WHEREAS**, the Boston Redevelopment Authority, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Office of Arts & Culture; and
