Subject of the hearing will be applications for Certificates of Design Approval on the agenda below, review of architectural violations and such business as may come before the commission, in accordance with Ch. 772 of the Acts of 1975, as amended. Applications are available for review, by appointment, during business hours at the office of the Environment Department. Applicants or their representatives are required to attend, unless indicated otherwise below. Sign-language interpreters are available upon request.

#### I. DESIGN REVIEW

#### 19.1174 AB 60 Washington Street

Applicant: Edward D. Pare, Jr., Esq.

Proposed Work: At roof relocate existing antenna concealment chimney to north corner of roof, add two additional antenna concealment chimneys, and add twelve remote radio units and three surge arrestors.

#### 18.1193 AB 40 Mount Hood Road

Applicant: James Grav. Stantec Proposed Work: Demolish existing post-war hotel structure: construct multifamily. mixed use development ranging from five to seven stories; install landscaping and hardscaping.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW/APPROVAL: In order to expedite the review process, the commission has delegated the approval of certain work items, such as those involving ordinary maintenance and repair, restoration or replacement, or which otherwise have a minimal impact on a building's appearance, to the commission staff pending ratification at its monthly public hearing. Having been identified as meeting these eligibility criteria and all applicable guidelines, the following applications will be approved at this hearing:

► <u>Applicants whose projects are listed under this heading NEED NOT APPEAR at the hearing</u>. Following the hearing, you will be issued a Determination Sheet to present at the Inspectional Services Department (1010 Massachusetts Avenue) as proof of project approval when applying for permits. ISD personnel will send an electronic copy of your building-permit application to the commission staff for review. (To avoid potential confusion, the text of your building-permit application should be consistent with the project description given below.) Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant guidelines and precedents.

The electronic building-permit application as annotated by commission staff will constitute your Certificate of Design Approval; this will be valid for two years from the date of the hearing. The applicant is required to notify the commission of any project changes; failure to do so may affect the status of the approval.
